



## Automatic Voter Registration for Wisconsin: Candidate Pledge of Support

I support establishing a system of Automatic Voter Registration in the state of Wisconsin. Automatic Voter Registration will boost registration rates, increase voter turnout, clean up the rolls, make voting more convenient, reduce the potential for voter fraud, and lower costs to taxpayers.

When an eligible citizen shares residency information to the State of Wisconsin -- for example, to renew a driver's license, buy a fishing license, or register for classes at a technical college or UW system school -- they should be automatically registered to vote unless they choose to opt out. No separate voter registration process or paper form should be required -- the information should be electronically and securely sent to the Wisconsin Elections Commission to be added to the poll lists. Once a voter is on the poll list, they should be permanently registered. Any time a consenting citizen changes their address with a state agency, such as the DMV, that information should be updated in their voter file.

I pledge to use my office to support Automatic Voter Registration in the ways and means available to me as a public official including, but not limited to, sponsoring or cosponsoring bills, voting in favor of such bills in committee, subcommittee, floor or other votes, working to build bipartisan support, and publicly advocating for the necessity of Automatic Voter Registration.
